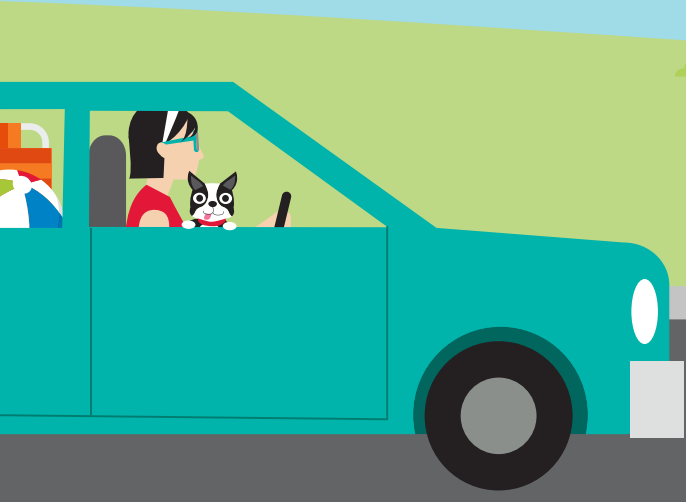

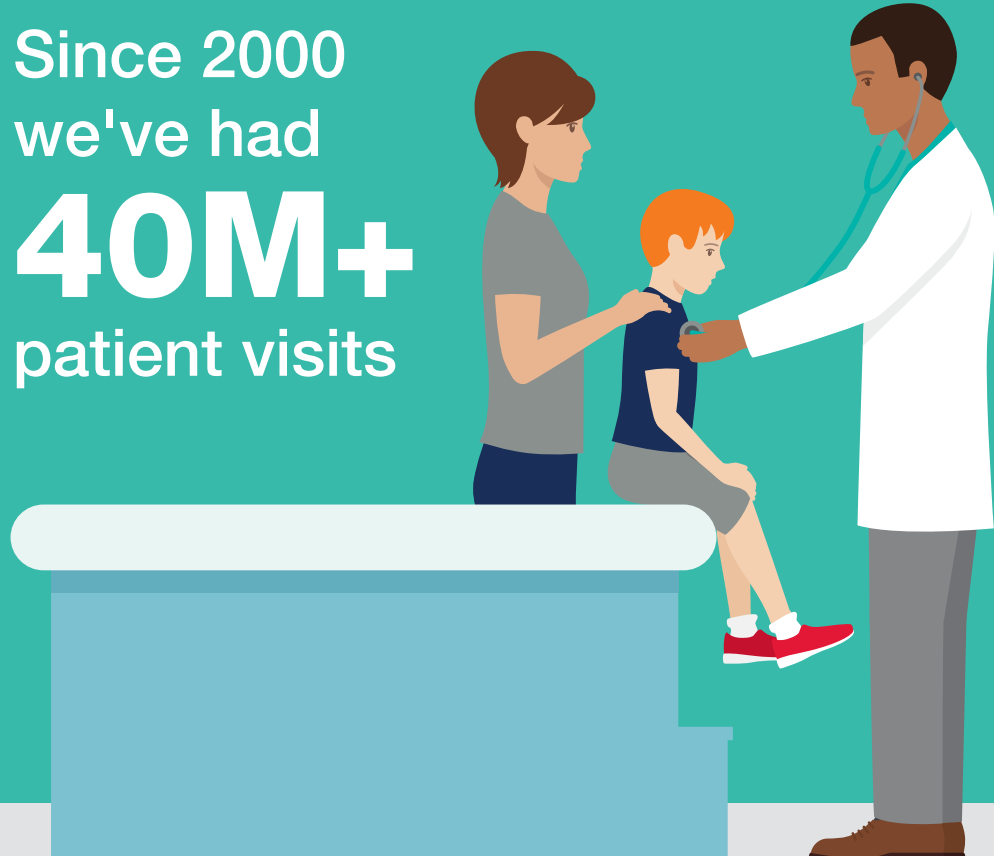

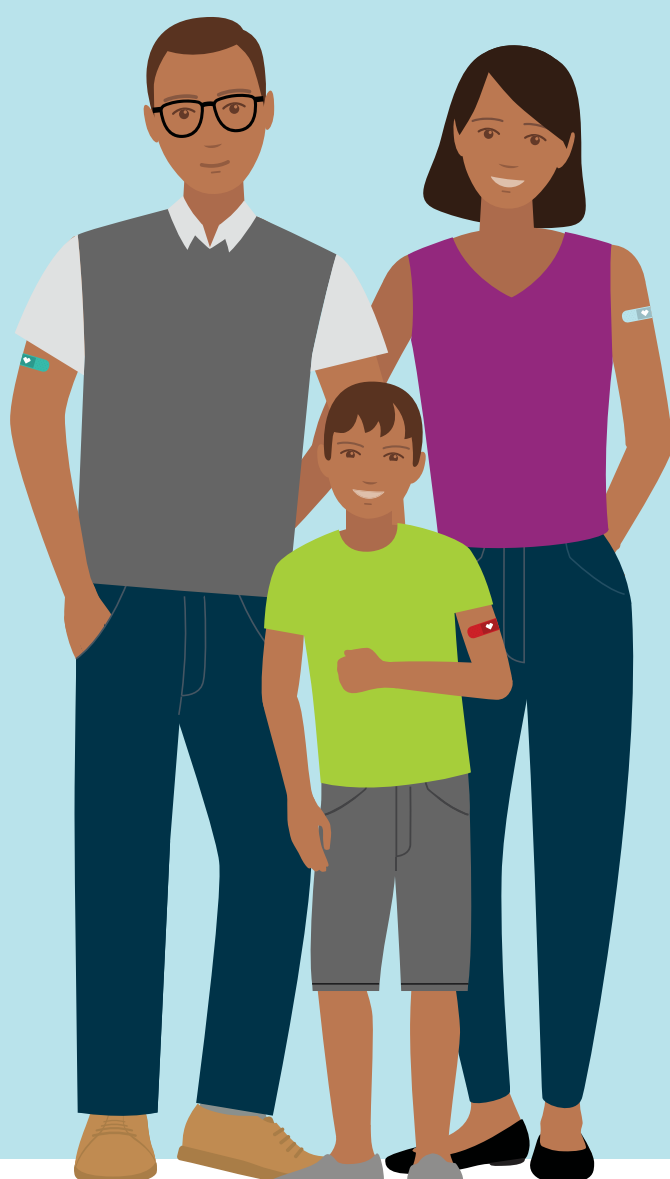
Diagnoses and treats sexually transmitted infections
